

2017 JETS / JETTS TOURNAMENT COED RULES

The General Playing rules listed on the Jets/Jetts website (www.jetsjetts.org/tournament/rules.pdf) shall apply in addition to the following specific rules of the COED divisions:

- A minimum of three (3) girls will be on the court at all times. If a girl fouls out and cannot be replaced by another girl, then the team shall play shorthanded. A maximum of two (2) boys is allowed on the court at all times.
- Boys cannot shoot from within the key and cannot land in the key after any shot. In both instances, the whistle will be blown as a violation, and no points will be awarded. Possession will be awarded to the defense.
- Boys cannot block girls' shots. If a boy blocks a girl's shot, the shot attempt will be counted as
 a basket and the possession will change. Any contact with a girl's shot will be considered a
 blocked shot.
- If a girl is fouled by a boy during the act of shooting, the shot shall be counted as a made basket and one free throw will be awarded to the fouled girl.
- There is no 30-second clock for COED.
- Teams will have 10 seconds to bring the ball past half-court after a change of possession. The 10 seconds will not restart after a timeout.
- Except for the last 2 minutes of the second half and overtime, boys will not be allowed to trap, guard or steal the ball from girls in the backcourt. If a boy traps, guards or steals the ball from a girl in the backcourt, then the whistle shall be blown and the ball awarded (back) to the offense. Boys may intercept passes from girls in the backcourt.
- When a foul is judged by the referee to be excessively physical, a flagrant foul will be assessed. Two free-throws will be awarded to the fouled player and that player's team will retain possession after the free-throws. Decisions regarding ejection of the player who commits the foul will be made by the referee(s). However, two flagrant fouls by the same player will result in immediate ejection.
- The ball size for all games will be 28.5 inches. Game balls will be provided by participating teams at the discretion of the referee(s).
- No "trash talking" will be allowed. An individual's first offense will result in a
 2 shot technical foul and possession to the other team. An individual will be immediately ejected after the second offense.

Note: The tournament committee reserves the right to move teams up or down in age group in the interest of fair competition.
